**MECHANICS:**  
Position and movement during play; position substitutions; correct, clear and visible time-outs, substitutions and between game

**CALLING THE MATCH**

**SETTING:**  
Consistency; tight; loose; setter vs. non-setter; call relative communication to sound; call relative to body position; Lifts; double hits.

**COMMUNICATION:**  
Coordination and communication with R1; with scorer's table; communication with Coaches and benches during match.

**PASSING/DIGGING:**  
Consistency; tight; loose; lifts; timing of calls; balls played at time of out of net; overhead dig.

**POSITION VIOLATIONS:**  
Understands complex formations; attentive service; uses good judgment; alert to back-row attack/block.

**BLOCKING:**  
Net violations; illegal blockers; held ball on joust; touch Calls, blocking recovery plays, reach-over; directional blocking.

**NET PLAY:**  
Net violations; centerline violations; antenna violations

**ATTACKING:**  
Power tips; illegal attacker; attack recovery plays; net violations, touch calls; dumps 4 hits

**BALL HANDLING ASSISTANCE:**  
Assists when needed; appropriate signals; valid judgment.
